

# WORLINGWORTH SOCIAL CLUB

The Social Club has had another really busy year, primarily running the Community Centre bar. A lot of funds have been raised, which have enabled a lot of money to be spent for the benefit of all.

The Social Club have paid to have the Community Centre hall and bar area re-decorated, donated money towards the new Community Centre doors, purchased a new ice machine and glass washer in the bar, paid for the trophies for the cars and bikes at the annual fete, paid for insurance and premises certificates and donated a free drink to all those attending the Senior's Christmas party.

As always, we are in desperate need of more volunteers to come forward and help to run the bar, the more there are the easier it is to spread the load.

The Social Club is also responsible for the annual firework display, (which has run for 29 years), however this year, due to new regulations and restrictions put in place by the insurance providers, more marshals are needed to run the event. The actual fireworks are set off by fully trained operatives, but we need people to come forward to manage car parking, a special sparkler area and to ensure that the public stay on the right side of the tapes. This is addition to the normal barbecue duties and gatekeepers, which is done by the Social Club committee. Volunteers need to come forward by August at the latest or it might be necessary to cancel. Also, the insurance company has quoted a figure of £600 on top of our usual annual insurances for the firework event - which is only for 1½ hours - fundraising will need to take place to raise this extra amount.
